RE: REPORT ON DISSEMINATION OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT MANAGEMENT OF SERVICE DELIVERY PERFORMANCE ASSESSMENT RESULTS.

Background

Office of the Prime Minister (OPM) coordinates the annual local government management of service delivery (LGMSD) performance assessment in line with the third objective of the Uganda

Intergovernmental Fiscal Transfer (UgIFT) programme which covers;

- I. Higher Local Government on their management of service delivery
- II. Local Climate Adaptive living facility initiative
- III. Disbursement linked indicators for Central Government oversight and support to local government service delivery
- IV. Lower local governments and service delivery centre (primary schools and health facilities)

As a requirement, OPM undertook dissemination of assessment results to individual local governments in line with the UgIFT Programme Operation Manual (POM) and Kamuli municipality also disseminated the assessment results to its stakeholders as follows;-

The Local government assessment in four measurable service delivery areas indicated as above shows that all departments performed above average with Education having the least performance of 75%

Kamuli Municipal Council improved in its performance from 176 in 2024 to 43 position in 2025 and its performance was associated with incentive increase of Ugx. 1,310,214,979= at 62% gain.

Challenges

- ❖ Misreporting by the LLG differently from first assessment assessors
- ❖ Absence of the respondents at the LLGs sampled with correct information based on the previous assessment
- ❖ Poor record management at the LLGs
- ❖ Capacity issues of the LLGs to concrete on evidence captured
- ❖ Delays in conducting assessment of the LLGs by the HLGs attributed to late release of funds
- ❖ Lack of adequate preparation and internal mock assessment.

Recommendation

- ❖ Enhance capacity of LGs to conduct time mock assessment at both HLGs and LLGs.
- ❖ Local government ensures that all reports are submitted in time and records are kept for further management.
- ❖ All documents used during assessment should be kept for future reference unit of assessment process is complete.
